



## 2009 Vendor Application – Revised

Thank you for your interest in selling your products and/or services at the Villebois Sunday Market. **Please be sure to read this application thoroughly before completing.**

The Villebois Sunday Market is the only farmers' market in Wilsonville, Ore. The market opened May 3, and runs from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Sundays through October 18.

### About the Villebois Sunday Market

As of our seventh week, June 14, we are averaging a total of 792 people coming through the market each week. Our goal is to grow to 3,500 total weekly visitors by the end of the season. Within five to 10 years, market management expects weekly traffic to be around 10,000 people.

The Villebois Sunday Market is located at the corner of SW Barber Street and Villebois Drive in the neighborhood development of Villebois on Wilsonville's west side. Once complete, the Villebois neighborhood is projected to have 2,500 homes and up to 7,000 residents. According to the US Census Bureau's 2006 Estimate, Wilsonville is home to 16,885 Oregonians (in terms of population, Wilsonville is 20 percent the size of Beaverton). In 2000, the median (annual) income for a household was \$52,515, and the median income for a family was \$65,172. These income levels were higher than the county, state and national median income levels. As one vendor put it, our shoppers are "educated, discerning shoppers."

Costa Pacific Homes, Arbor Homes and Riverstone Property Management are underwriting the costs of the market's first season. The Villebois Sunday Market is a nonprofit organization in the state of Oregon and is awaiting federal 501(c)(3) status.

### Submission Instructions

Applications are reviewed biweekly on the second and fourth Tuesdays of the month. **Please do not contact market management to check on the status of your application, as messages will not be returned.** Please be sure to utilize the attached application checklist. Incomplete applications will delay market management's ability to review your application. **There is no application fee for the 2009 season.**

Market management will notify you via email to acknowledge receipt of your application. You will be notified via email of the status of your application on the Wednesday following your review date (this will either be the second or the fourth Wednesday of the month).

### **Vendor Categories**

The Villebois Sunday Market only accepts vendors whose products are produced and/or manufactured and/or whose services are provided in the states of Oregon and Washington. Prospective vendors may find that their product and/or service mix includes more than one vendor category. If so, please be sure to list products and/or services by category, then sale date.

#### *Farms and Nurseries*

Seventy-five percent of Villebois Sunday Market vendors fall within this category. Vendors in this category sell produce, flowers, nuts, plants, herbs, etc. Preference will be given to vendors who sell organic products (proof of organic registration required). Vendors in this category may be required to have a scale license and/or a nursery license.

#### *Processed Foods*

Vendors in this category sell packaged goods, such as nuts, honey, cheese, jellies, baked goods, juices, etc. Preference will be given to vendors who sell organic products (proof of organic registration required). Vendors in this category may be required to have a food processing and/or certified kitchen license, food handler's permit, dairy and/or meat license and/or a scale license.

#### *Prepared Foods – This category is full for the remainder of the 2009 season*

Vendors in this category will sell food and beverage products that are prepared onsite for immediate consumption. Preference will be given to vendors who sell organic products (proof of organic registration required). Most vendors in this category will be required to have a temporary restaurant license and/or a food handler's permit.

#### *Crafter and/or Artisan*

Vendors in this category sell handmade yard art, furniture, crafts, jewelry, soaps, etc. Preference will be given to vendors who sell organic products (proof of organic registration required). Vendors in this category are not required to have materials sourced in Oregon and Washington – although, it is preferred – but vendors are required to have produced their products (i.e. created, made, manufactured) in the states of Oregon and/or Washington. This category is highly competitive, as limited space is available. Vendors in this category are approved on a trial basis and continued participation is approved based on a mix of vendor profitability and community feedback.

#### *Business and/or NGO/NPO – This category is full for the remainder of the 2009 season*

Vendors in this category provide a product and/or service that are educational and/or beneficial to the community and match the market's mission (see home page of market Web site). License requirements vary by vendor. Businesses and/or NGO/NPOs who are not able to vend at the market are encouraged to consider sponsorship opportunities with the market to promote their product and/or service to market shoppers.

### **Market Fees and Stall Options**

The base package is a 10x10 stall for \$25 per week. A limited number of double stalls are available at \$45 per week. Triple stalls, which are \$60 per week, are sold out for the season. A limited number of tabletop spaces (10x5) are available – by special request only – for \$12.50. Checks should be made payable to the *Villebois Village Center*, which is providing complimentary bookkeeping services to the market.

Vendors are able to receive a 10 percent discount for prepayment of 11 (consecutive or non-consecutive) weeks.

### **Promotional Opportunities for Vendors**

In addition to the market Web site, where approved vendors are able to have a link to their own Web sites included, the Villebois Sunday Market hosts a market blog at [www.VilleboisSundayMarket.blogspot.com](http://www.VilleboisSundayMarket.blogspot.com) and invites vendors to contribute posts to the blog about their product and/or service mix, any specials they'll be offering and when they're adding new products.

For vendors who are with us each week, we will be starting a Vendor of the Week program and that vendor will be featured on the market Web site, blog and in our communications with the community and local media.

## Application Checklist

The following checklist will help ensure you submit a complete application to market management. Incomplete applications will delay market management's ability to review your application.

- Did you complete pages three through five of the application?
- Did you include a copy of any licenses needed in order to conduct your business and/or sell your products and/or services?
- If you are a prepared food vendor, did you include an electronic copy of your menu (PDF format preferred)?
- If you are a farm or nursery, did you complete the supplemental application at the end of this document?
- Did you include a complete (i.e. comprehensive) list of the products and/or services you would like to sell?
- Did you include the pricing for your products and/or services?
- Did you include a 100-word vendor profile in an electronic format (plain text or MS Word format) *with* your application?
- Did you read the market handbook? Were your questions answered?
- Did you include a photo of your booth and the products and/or services you offer? (Please note: market management prefers electronic photos in a JPG or GIF format.)
